

**Notice Under Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning  
(Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales)  
Regulations 1999**

**Proposed development on land between Newtown and the  
proposed Garreg Lwyd Hill Wind Farm**

The application was made to Powys County Council on 18th July 2013 and is the subject of an appeal to the Welsh Ministers.

**Appeal Reference: APP/T6850/A/13/2209595**

Notice is hereby given that RES UK and Ireland Limited has prepared 'other information', to the Environmental Statement that accompanied its application in July 2013 to Powys County Council.

The proposed development for which planning permission is being sought comprises highway upgrades and associated works on land between Newtown and the proposed Garreg Lwyd Hill Wind Farm to facilitate deliveries of abnormal loads and the construction of a new track and upgraded track from Cwm y Berllwyd across the proposed Llanbadarn Fynydd Wind Farm to access the proposed Garreg Lwyd Hill Wind Farm.

This other information which has been submitted to the Welsh Ministers comprises the following:

- ∞ The December 2013 SE1 submitted in relation the section 36 Application for the proposed Llanbadarn Fynydd wind farm together with its February 2014 update which assessed the likely significant environmental effects of that development in relation to a revision to Section 6 of the sTMP
- ∞ Additional ecological survey updates
- ∞ Re-assessment of traffic impacts in light of the reduction in turbines on the associated proposed Garreg Lwyd Hill Wind Farm scheme from 23 turbines to 17
- ∞ A Non-Technical Summary ("NTS")
