

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –
SECTION 14(1)(A)**

**THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (WOLFSHEAD TO QUEEN'S
HEAD, SHROPSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION
OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2015**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A5 Trunk Road, between Wolfshead and Queen's Head in the County of Shropshire, to allow resurfacing and associated works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 between the roundabout junction with the B4396 at Wolfshead and the junction with the B5009 at Queen's Head.

The work will be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 2 February 2015 and continue for three weeks. The order will come into force on Monday 26 January 2015.

Vehicles being used by the emergency services and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via the A458 and A483 and vice versa will be signed. Access to property will be maintained at all times.
