Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn ddim cynt na 7 diwrnod o 28 Ionawr 2015 a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio hyd gyfan y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd Dosbarth III a elwir yn Bontuchel i Glocaenog. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn hwylyso gwaith ail-wynebu gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych – yr Uned Waith.

Bydd y ffordd amgen i draffig yn mynd trwy Fontuchel i gyffordd Penrhengoed, cyffordd Penrhengoed i Bryn Ffynnon, B5105, Bryn Ffynnon i Dyn Celyn, cyffordd Glandwr i Old School Cottage, a bydd arwyddion i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Bydd y Gorchymyn yn dod i rym ar 16 Chwefror 2015 ac yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 2 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 28th January 2015 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Class III road known as Bontuchel to Clocaenog for its entire length. The reason for the closure is to facilitate resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council – Works Unit

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Bontuchel to Penrhengoed junction, Penrhengoed junction to Bryn Ffynnon, B5105, Bryn Ffynnon to Tyn Celyn, Glandwr junction to Old School Cottage, and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 16th February 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.
