- 2) Wood Road; o'i chyffordd ag Ellis Avenue am bellter o oddeutu 54 metr.
- 3) Ellis Avenue; o'i chyffordd â Warren Road am bellter o oddeutu 54 metr.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends no sooner than 7 days from the date hereof to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using the roads referred to in the Schedule. The closure is to facilitate a traffic calming scheme. The alternative routes will be as stated in the Schedule and will be sign posted. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order will come into force on 14th March 2015 for an eighteen month period or the earlier completion of the works. The works will take approximately 9 days to complete.

**Schedule
Lengths of Roads at Rhyl**

- 1) Warren Road; approximately 75 metres from its junction with Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 69 metres.
- 2) Wood Road; from its junction with Ellis Avenue for a distance of approximately 54 metres.
- 3) Ellis Avenue; from its junction with Warren Road for a distance of approximately 54 metres.

Alternative routes:

- 1) North of Ellis Avenue – Wellington Road/South of Ellis Avenue – Seabank Road, Westbourne Avenue and Wellington Road.
- 2) Westbourne Avenue, Wellington Road.
- 3) Garnett Avenue, Ffynnongroew Road and Wellington Road.
