NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule below. The reason for the closure is to facilitate environmental improvement works by Denbighshire County Council - Works Unit.

The alternative routes available for traffic will be as stated in the Schedule and will be signposted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 1st March 2015, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take 5 weeks to complete

Schedule - Lengths of Roads at Rhyl in the County of Denbigh

1. **High Street**; from its junction with Wellington Road to its junction with Brighton Road
 2. **Wellington Road**; from its junction with Bodfor Street to its junction with Russell road
 3. **Russell Road**; from its junction with Wellington road to its junction with Clwyd street.
- Alternative routes**
1. Via Kinmel Street, Bodfor Street Wellington Road, Bath Street and Brighton Road
 2. & 3. Via Queen Street, West Parade, East Parade, Church Street and Russell Road
