DEDDF RHEOLEIDDIO TRAFFIG FFYRDD 1984 – ADUAN 14**

Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, dim cynt na 7 niwrnod o 4 Mawrth 2015 sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r ffordd Dosbarth III a elwir yn Ddrws y Buddel hyd at Lyn Clywedog Saron yn Sir Ddinbych o'i chyffordd â Ffordd Bryn Golau i gyfeiriad y de orllewin am bellter o tua 692 metr.
Y rheswm dros gau'r ffordd yw er mwyn hwyluso gwaith trydanol gan O'Connor Utilities.

Bydd y ffordd arall ar gyfer traffig wedi'i harwyddbostio o Gronfa ddŵr Clywedog i Marial Gwyn, Tal y Cefn Isa i Garnedd Ci, Ty'n Llwyn, Hafod Wen, B5105, Ffordd Rhuthun, B4501, Saron i Nant y Ci a Phentre Saron at y gyffordd â Heol Bryn Tirion a ffordd o Ben y Ffridd. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Bydd y Gorchymyn yn dod i rym ar 23 Mawrth 2015 ac yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 6 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 4th March 2015 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using the Class III road known as Drws y Buddel to Clywedog Reservoir Saron in the County of Denbigh from its junction with Bryn Golau Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 692 metres. The reason for the closure is to facilitate electrical works by O'Connor Utilities.

The alternative route available for traffic will be signposted via Clywedog reservoir to Marial Gwyn, Tal y Cefn Isa to Garnedd Ci, Ty'n Llwyn, Hafod Wen, B5105, Ruthin Road, B4501, Saron to Nant y Ci, and Pentre Saron to the junction with Bryn Tirion Road, and road from Pen y Ffridd. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 23rd March 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 6 weeks to complete.
