

LICENSING ACT 2003 NOTICE OF APPLICATION
TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER SECTION 34

Notice is hereby given that on the 2nd March 2015 **Enterprise Inns Plc** applied to Flintshire County Council for a variation of the Premises Licence in respect of premises **The Dolphin**, 86/88 High Street, Mold, Flintshire CH7 1BH. The proposed variation is: 1. To amend the terminal hour for all licensable activities to 0100 hours. 2. To remove all non standard timings. 3. To add certain conditions. 4. To remove an obsolete condition. Any representations by a responsible authority or any other person regarding the above-mentioned application must be received in writing by: Chief Public Protection Officer, Flintshire County Council, County Hall, Mold CH7 6NF no later than 30th March 2015 stating the grounds for representations. The register of Flintshire County Council and the record of the application may be inspected at the Council offices at Environment & Regeneration, Entrance 3, County Hall, Mold CH7 6NF during normal office hours. It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is £5,000.
