Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, ddim cynt na 7 diwrnod o 11 Mawrth 2015, a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r rhan o Ffordd yn Saron yn Sir Ddinbych rhwng Pen y Ffridd a Drws y Buddel. Y rheswm am y cau yw er mwyn hwyluso gwaith trydanol gan O'Connor Utilities.

Bydd arwyddion ar gyfer y ffordd arall ar gael i draffig drwy Ffordd Bryn Golau, Saron, i Nant y Ci a Phentre Saron at y gyffordd â Heol Bryn Tirion. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Bydd y Gorchymyn yn dod i rym ar 30 Mawrth 2015 ac yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 4 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 11th March 2015 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using the length of road at Saron in the County of Denbigh between Pen y Ffridd and Drws y Buddel. The reason for the closure is to facilitate electrical works by O'Connor Utilities.

The alternative route available for traffic will be signposted via Bryn Golau Road, Saron to Nant y Ci, and Pentre Saron to the junction with Bryn Tirion Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 30th March 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete.
