Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu ddim cynharach na 7 diwrnod o 18 Mawrth 2015 i wneud Gorchymyn sy'n cau 564 metr o Lwybr Rhwydwaith Beicio Cenedlaethol 84 i feicwyr a cherddwyr rhwng y cyfesurynnau 302056 377797 / 302123 377360 ger yr A525 yn Rhuddlan. Mae angen cau'r rhan hon o'r llwybr i osod cylched orfodi newydd o dan y ddaear gan Scottish Power. Gyfochr â llwybr 84 bydd llwybr dargyfeiriol yn rhedeg drwy Warchodfa Natur Rhuddlan.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 8 Ebrill 2015 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 3 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 18th March 2015 to make an Order which will close a 564 metre section of National Cycle Network Route 84 to cyclists and pedestrians between the coordinates 302056 377797 / 302123 377360 adjacent to the A525 carriageway at Rhuddlan. The closure is needed to facilitate installation of a new underground re-enforcement circuit by Scottish Power. A diversionary route will run in parallel passing through Rhuddlan Nature Reserve.

The Order will come into force on 8th April 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 3 weeks to complete.
