**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**Temporary Restriction of Pedestrians**

**Public Footpath No. 5 Upton by Chester**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrians on that length of Public Footpath No. 5 Upton by Chester which commences at OS grid reference SJ 4111 6967 and runs in a generally south–easterly then easterly direction for approximately 47 metres to OS grid reference SJ 4115 6966 at Flag Lane North.

The closure is necessary while works to construct a sewer and ditch headwall are undertaken. The works are expected to take approximately three months to complete.

The Order will come into force on 23 July 2009 and will continue in force for a period of six months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

## **Details of alternative route:**

An alternative route is available on the footway alongside the A41 Moston Road. Pedestrians are advised to follow the alternative route.
