



**Gorchymyn Sir Powys
(Ffordd y B4393 rhwng Four
Crosses a Choedway)**

**(Terfynau cyflymder 30 MYA a 50
MYA) (Diwygiad Rhif 1) 201**

Rhoddir rhybudd drwy hyn bod Cyngor Sir Powys yn bwriadu diwygio Gorchymyn Sir Powys (Sir Drefaldwyn) (Ffordd y B4393 rhwng Four Crosses a Choedway) (Cyfyngiadau Cyflymder 30MYA a 50MYA) 2005 dan Adran 84(1) a (2) y Ddeddf Rheoli Traffig y Ffyrdd, 1984.

Pan ddaw'r Gorchymyn diwygiedig hwn i rym bydd yn anghyfreithlon i yrru cerbyd ar gyflymder y tu hwnt i drideg milltir yr awr ar hyd y rhan honno o ffordd y B4393 ym Mhont Llandrinio sy'n ymestyn o fan tua 150 metr i'r gogledd-orllewin o'i chyffordd â'r C2038 ym Mhont Llandrinio am bellter o tua 400 metr i gyfeiriad y de-ddwyrain.

Mae manylion y cynnig hwn wedi'u cynnwys yn y Gorchymyn drafft sydd, ynghyd â'r map sy'n dangos y rhan o'r ffordd dan sylw, a datganiad o resymau'r Cyngor dros gynnig y Gorchymyn, i'w gweld yn Neuadd y Sir, Llandrindod a Gorsaf Betrol a Swyddfa Bost Llandrinio yn ystod oriau agor arferol.

**(30 MPH and 50 MPH Speed Limits)
(Amendment No. 1) Order 201**

Notice is hereby given that Powys County Council proposes to modify The County of Powys (Montgomeryshire) (B4393 Road between Four Crosses and Coedway) (30 MPH and 50 MPH Speed Limits) Order 2005 under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

When this modified Order comes into effect it will be unlawful to drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour in that length of the B4393 road at Llandrinio Bridge in the community of Llandrinio which extends from a point approximately 150 metres north-west of its junction with the C2038 at Llandrinio Bridge for a distance of approximately 400 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Details of this proposal are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the length of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during office hours at County Hall, Llandrindod Wells and at Llandrinio Service Station and Post Office during normal opening hours.
