

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14  
THE A550 TRUNK ROAD (A5117 A494 AND A550  
WESTBOUND EXIT SLIP ROADS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF  
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2015**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A550 Trunk Road, A494 and A5117 road in the District of Cheshire West and Chester in the County of Cheshire to enable the routine cyclic maintenance works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to take place overnight between 2000 hours and 0600 hours starting on Tuesday 5 May 2015 and ending on Wednesday 6 May 2015. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed.

The Order will impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the following section of the A494 commencing 60 metres prior to the tip of the A494 entry slip to the A494 Queensferry/North Wales and finishing 375 metres prior to Deeside Park Interchange centrepont.

The Order will ban all traffic from the following:

- (a) the westbound off slip from the A5117 (M56) from a point 145 metres east of the nosing at the start of the slip for a total length of 872 meters in England and 139 metres in Wales. A total of 1011 metres to where the slip road joins the Deeside Park Roundabout;
- (b) the A550 (M53) westbound exit slip road from a point 220 metres east of the nosing at the start of the slip road for a total length of 435 metres in England 135 metres in Wales a total of 570 metres to the nosing where the slip road joins the Deeside Park Roundabout.

Traffic wishing to travel westbound on the A550 link road will be directed to join the A494, Queensferry interchange. Traffic will take the Queensferry westbound exit slip road and then take the fifth exit to re-join the A494/A550 eastbound, where the diversion will end at Deeside Park Interchange.

Traffic wishing to travel westbound on the A5117 will be directed to continue along the A5117 towards the A494. Traffic will take the Queensferry westbound exit slip road and then take the fifth exit to re-join the A494/A550 eastbound, where the diversion will end at Deeside Park Interchange.

The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as will be indicated by traffic signs and will not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works or by traffic officers, or to vehicles being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services.
