GORCHYMYN (CYFYNGIAD CYFLYMDER 40 MYA) 2015

Ar 21 Ebrill 2015 gwnaeth Cyngor Sir Ddinbych Orchymyn dan adrannau 82(2) 83(2) 84(1) ac 84 (2) a Rhan III a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, a ddaw i rym ar 27 Ebrill 2015.

Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd gorfodi cyfyngiad cyflymder o 40 milltir yr awr ar hyd y darn o ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen y rhybudd hwn, ac mae rhan ohoni eisoes yn destun cyfyngiad cyflymder 40 milltir yr awr a orfodir gan y gorchymyn y cyfeirir ato isod sy'n cael ei ddiddymu'n gyfan gwbl.

Mae Gorchymyn Cyngor Sir Ddinbych (Cyfyngiad Cyflymder 40 mya) (Rhif 1) 1965 yn cael ei ddiddymu, ac effaith hyn fydd cyflwyno cyfyngiad cyflymder o 30mya ar hyd y rhan fwyaf o'r ffordd sy'n destun y Gorchymyn hwnnw oherwydd agosrwydd y polion golau stryd presennol.

Gellir archwilio copi o'r Gorchymyn, a'r gorchymyn a ddiddymwyd ynghyd â chynlluniau yn dangos y darnau o ffordd y mae'r Gorchymyn yn ymwneud â nhw yn Llyfrgell Dinbych, Sgwâr y Neuadd, Dinbych a Llyfrgell Rhuthun, Stryd y Llys, Rhuthun a Neuadd y Sir, Ffordd Wynnstay, Rhuthun yn ystod oriau agor arferol.

Y darn o'r A525 sy'n mynd o bwynt 125 metr i'r gogledd orllewin o'i chyffordd â'r ffordd ddienw sydd agosaf at Ganolfan Addysg Ysgol Bro Cinmeirch (os yw wedi'i fesur ar hyd yr ymyl gogledd ddwyreiniol) i gyfeiriad y de ddwyrain i bwynt 63 metr i'r gogledd orllewin o'i chyffordd â'r ffordd ddienw sy'n mynd rhwng croesffordd Llanrhaeadr a chroesffordd Groesffordd (os yw wedi'i fesur ar hyd yr ymyl de orllewinol).

DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A525 LLANRHAEADR)
(40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2015

On 21st April 2015 Denbighshire County Council made an Order under sections 82(2) 83(2) 84(1) and 84 (2) and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into effect on 27th April 2015.

The effect of the Order is to impose a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice, a part of which is presently subject to a 40 miles per hour speed limit imposed by the order referred to below which is revoked in its entirety.

The County of Denbigh The County Council of Denbigh (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.1) Order 1965 is revoked having the effect of introducing a 30 mph speed limit on most of the length of road covered by that Order by virtue of the proximity of existing street lighting columns.

Copies of the Order, and order revoked together with plans showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined at Denbigh Library, Hall Square, Denbigh and Ruthin Library, Record Street, Ruthin and at County Hall, Wynnstay Road, Ruthin during normal opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained within it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from 21st April 2015, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE
Length of road at Llanrhaeadr in the County of Denbigh
40 mph Speed Restriction

That length of A525 which extends from a point 125 metres north west of its junction with the unnamed road nearest to Canolfan Addysg Ysgol Bro Cinmeirch School (when measured along the north eastern kerb line) in a south easterly direction to a point 63 metres north west of its junction with the unnamed road which runs between the Llanrhaeadr crossroads and the Groesffordd crossroads (when measured along the south western kerb line).
