Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn dan Adrannau 1(1), 2(1) i (3), 4(2), a 124 a Rhan III a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, a'r holl bwerau galluogi eraill i dynnu'r cyfyngiad parcio presennol ar y ffordd y cyfeirir ati yn yr Atodlen isod.

Bydd Gorchymyn Cyngor Sir Ddinbych (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros a Mannau Parcio ar y Stryd) (Cydgrynhoi) 2004 yn cael ei ddiddymu ar gyfer y rhan o'r ffordd y cyfeirir ati yn y Gorchymyn bwriedig. Ym mhob modd arall, bydd y Gorchymyn Cydgrynhoi yn aros yr un fath.

NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF EXISTING WAITING RESTRICTION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Denbighshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), and 124 and Part III, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to remove the existing parking restriction on the length of road as referred to in the Schedule below.

The Denbighshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004 is to be revoked in so far as it relates to the length of road referred to in the proposed Order. In all other respects the Consolidation Order remains unchanged.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the lengths of roads to which the proposals relate, and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at Rhyll Library, Church Street, Rhyll and at the offices of the undersigned.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send a written statement of objection, stating the grounds on which they are made, to the Head of Legal HR and Democratic Services, County Hall, Wynnstay Road, Ruthin by no later than 29th May 2015. Persons objecting should be aware their name and address details may need to be shared with appropriate third parties.
