Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn ddim cyn 7 diwrnod o 20 Mai 2015 a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio Lôn Parc, Dinbych, Sir Ddinbych sy'n ymestyn o bwynt oddeutu 90 metr o'i chyffordd â Sgwâr y Neuadd am bellter o oddeutu 22 metr. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn galluogi Dŵr Cymru i atgyweirio carthffosydd.

Bydd y llwybr teithio amgen sydd ar gael i drafnidiaeth yn mynd ar hyd Peakes Lane, Stryd y Dyffryn a Sgwâr y Neuadd, a bydd arwyddion wedi'u gosod i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau. Bydd y system draffig unffordd yn cael ei hatal dros dro yn ystod y cyfnod cau.

Bydd y Gorchymyn yn dod i rym 8 Mehefin 2015 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis, neu nes bydd y gwaith wedi'i gwblhau, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 4 diwrnod i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 20th May 2015 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using Park Street Denbigh in the County of Denbigh extending from a point approximately 90 metres from its junction with Hall Square for a distance of approximately 22 metres. The reason for the closure is to facilitate sewer repairs by Welsh Water.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Peakes Lane, Vale Street and Hall Square and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure. The one-way traffic system will be temporarily suspended during the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 8th June 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 4 days to complete.
