**DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(THE LAWN, RHYL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 201.  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

On 19th May 2015 Denbighshire County Council made the above-named Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), and 124 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to introduce prohibition of waiting of vehicles on the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule below.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading and unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions are also provided in the Order to allow vehicles displaying both a Disabled Person's Badge and a Disabled Person's Parking Disc to wait on the said lengths of road specified in the Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day).

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 25th May 2015, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined at Rhyl Library, Church Street Rhyl and at County Hall Wynnstay Road, Ruthin during normal opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 19th May 2015 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Lengths of Road at Rhyl in the County of Denbigh  
No Waiting At Any Time**

**The Lawn;**

**North east side;** From the extended kerbline of the junction between The Lawn and Russell Road for a distance of 17 metres in a north westerly direction.

**South west side;** From the extended kerbline of the junction between The Lawn and Russell Road for a distance of 16 metres in a north westerly direction.
