Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag teithio ar hyd:-

- (i) Ffordd Bastion Prestatyn yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Beach Road East i'w chyffordd â Beach Road West.
- (ii) Beach Road West Prestatyn, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Ffordd Bastion i'w chyffordd â First Avenue.

Mae angen cau'r darnau ffordd yma er mwyn i ISG Construction osod ffrâm ddrur a chladin yng Nghanolfan Nova.

Bydd y llwybr teithio arall sydd ar gael i drafnidiaeth yn mynd ar hyd The Mall a First Avenue a bydd arwyddion wedi'u gosod i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gyfodol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 20 Gorffennaf 2015 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 5 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER
DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
BASTION ROAD AND BEACH ROAD WEST, PRESTATYN
NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using those lengths of :-

- (i) Bastion Road Prestatyn in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with Beach Road East to its junction with Beach Road West.
- (ii) Beach Road West Prestatyn aforesaid which extends from its junction with Bastion Road to its junction with First Avenue.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate steel frame and cladding works in the Nova Centre by ISG Construction.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via The Mall and First Avenue and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 20th July 2015, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take 5 weeks to complete.
