## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Prohibition of Traffic

#### Lightfoot Street in Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in Chester to enable a new water main to be laid.

(1) Lightfoot Street, Chester from its junction with Hoole Road to its junction with Westminster Road.

Access to properties (via Hoole Rd/Faulkner St) and for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Monday, 20 July 2007 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately eleven weeks to complete.

#### Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via Hoole Lane, Canadian Avenue and Hoole Road.

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Traffic Restrictions

#### Various Roads in the Parish of Upton in Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic on the following lengths of road, in the Parish of Upton, in Cheshire to enable the construction of flood alleviation pipework works to be carried out.

1. Flag Lane North, Upton from its junction with A41 Moston Road to a point outside 2 Flag Lane North. From Monday, 10 August to Friday, 4 September 2009.
2. Heath Road, Upton from its junction with A41 Long Lane to its junction with Flag Lane South. From Monday, 7 September to Friday, 20 November 2009.
3. Flag Lane South, Upton from its junction with A41 Moston Road to its junction with Heath Road. No parking will be permitted between 07.00 and 19.00. From Monday, 7 September to Friday, 20 November 2009.
4. A41 Moston Road/Long Lane from its junction with Demage Lane to its junction with Weston Grove. From Monday, 10 August 2009 to Friday, 5 March 2010. Temporary 30mph speed restriction (reduced to 20 mph when works being carried out on A41).
5. Marina Drive, Upton from its junction with A41 Long Lane to its junction with Longfield Avenue. From Monday, 4 January to Friday, 5 March 2010.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Monday, 10 August 2009 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 25 weeks to complete.

#### Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via the following:

1. A41 Moston Road, Caughall Road and Oakfield Drive.
2. A41 Long Lane and Flag Lane South.
3. None
4. None
5. A41 Long Lane, Weston Grove and Dukesway.

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Prohibition of Traffic

#### Weston Grove and Cotebrook Drive in Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following lengths of road, in Chester to enable the construction of manholes separating surface and foul water.

1. Cotebrook Drive, Upton at its junction with Weston Grove. From Monday, 3 August to Monday, 24 August 2009.
2. Weston Grove, Upton from its junction with Cornwall Road to its junction with Newhall Road. From Monday, 27 July to Sunday, 16 August 2009.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Monday, 27 July 2009 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately four weeks to complete.

#### Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via the following:

1. Weston Grove, Gatesheath Drive and Oulton Avenue.
2. Cornwall Road, Aldford Road and Newhall Road.
