**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER  
DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ONE - WAY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 5th August 2015 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from travelling along Green Lane, Denbigh, in the County of Denbigh, which extends from its junction with A541 to its junction with A525, in any direction other than south west bound.

The reason for the restriction is to facilitate the safe movement of show traffic.

The Order will come into force on Thursday 20th August 2015 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months.
