Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, ddim cynharach na 7 diwrnod o 23 Medi, 2015, yn gwahardd cerbydau rhag defnyddio'r ffordd Dosbarth III a adwaenir fel Bache Mill Road, Llangollen, Sir Ddinbych o'i chyffordd â Phengwern i'w chyffordd â Butler Hill. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn hwyluso gwaith ail-wynebu gan Uned Waith - Cyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Y llwybr amgen gydag arwyddion fydd ar hyd Bache Mill Road, Heol y Bryn, Sgwâr y Neuadd, A5, Brook Street a Pengwern. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 7 Hydref 2015 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 2 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 23rd September 2015 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using the Class III road known as Bache Mill Road, Llangollen, Denbighshire from its junction with Pengwern to its junction with Butler Hill. The closure is necessary to facilitate resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council - Works Unit.

The signposted alternative route will be via Bache Mill Road, Heol y Bryn, Hall Square, A5, Brook Street and Pengwern. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 7th October 2015 for an eighteen month period or earlier completion of the works. It is anticipated the works will take approximately 2 weeks.
