Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd cerbydau rhag defnyddio Mostyn Avenue Prestatyn, yn Sir Ddinbych, yn ymestyn o'r gyffordd â Gronant Road hyd y gyffordd â Rhodfa Plas. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn i Gallagher Construction osod dwythell BT ar y ffordd gerbydau.

Bydd y llwybr teithio arall sydd ar gael i drafnidiaeth yn mynd drwy Rhodfa Plas, Rhodfa Clwyd, Stryd Fawr a Gronant Road, a bydd arwyddion wedi'u gosod i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 28 Medi 2015, a bydd yn para am ddeunaw mis neu tan y bydd y gwaith wedi'i gwblhau, pa un bynnag fydd gyntaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd 5 diwrnod i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits vehicles from using Mostyn Avenue Prestatyn in the County of Denbigh extending from its junction with Gronant Road to its junction with Plas Avenue. The closure is necessary to facilitate installation of a BT duct in carriageway by Gallagher Construction.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Plas Avenue, Clwyd Avenue, High Street and Gronant Road and will be sign posted. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 28th September 2015, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take 5 days to complete.
