Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag teithio ar hyd y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd gyswllt rhwng Brighton Road a Thorpe Street, y Rhyl, Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Thorpe Street am bellter o 25 metr i'r de orllewin. Y rheswm dros gau'r ffordd yw hwyluso atgyweiriadau i wal dalcen ansefydlog.

Bydd y llwybr teithio arall sydd ar gael i draffig yn mynd drwy Thorpe Street a Brighton Road a bydd arwyddion wedi'u gosod i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Mae'r Gorchymyn yn para deunaw mis, ond mae disgwyl i'r gwaith bara tan tua diwedd mis Hydref 2015.

LINK ROAD BETWEEN BRIGHTON ROAD AND THORPE STREET, RHYL
NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of the link road between Brighton Road and Thorpe Street, Rhyl, Denbighshire, which extends from its junction with Thorpe Street for a distance of 25 metres in a south westerly direction. The reason for the closures is to facilitate repairs to an unstable gable wall.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Thorpe Street and Brighton Road and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order has an eighteen month duration but the works are expected to last approximately until the end of October 2015.
