(GWAHARDDIAD AR AROS, LLWYTHO A DADLWYTHO AR UNRHYW ADEG) GORCHYMYN 2015  
DEDDF RHEOLEIDDIO TRAFFIG FFYRDD 1984**

Ar 22ain Medi 2015 gwnaeth Cyngor Sir Ddinbych y Gorchymyn uchod dan Adrannau 1(1), 2(1) i (3) a 4(2) a 124 a Rhan III a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, a'i effaith fydd:-

1) Cyflwyno gwaharddiad ar aros, llwytho a dadlwytho cerbydau ar unrhyw adeg ar y darnau ffordd y cyfeirir atynt yn Atodlen 1 isod.

Mae eithriadau yn y Gorchymyn i ganiatáu aros ar y ffordd y cyfeirir ati yn Atodlen 1 at ddibenion llwytho a dadlwytho a gwneud gwaith cynnal a chadw, trwsio ac ati.

Bydd Gorchymyn Cyngor Sir Ddinbych (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros a Mannau Parcio ar y Stryd) (Cydgrynhoi) 2004 yn cael ei ddiddymu ar gyfer y rhan o'r ffordd y cyfeirir ati yn y Gorchymyn bwriedig. Ym mhob modd arall, bydd y Gorchymyn yn aros yr un fath.

Gellir archwilio copi o'r Gorchymyn a ddaw i rym ar 28ain Medi 2015 ynghyd â map yn dangos yr hyd o'r ffordd y mae'r Gorchymyn yn ymwneud ag o yn Llyfrgell Prestatyn, 21 Kings Avenue, Prestatyn, LL19 9AA ac yn swyddfa'r sawl sydd wedi arwyddo isod.

**DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BASTION ROAD AND THE MALL, PRESTATYN)  
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME) ORDER 2015  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

On 22nd September 2015 Denbighshire County Council made the above-named Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and 124 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is :-

1) To introduce prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on the lengths of roads as referred to in Schedule 1 below.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit waiting in the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 for the purposes of alighting, boarding, and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

The Denbighshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004 is revoked in so far as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the Order. In all other respects the Order remains unchanged.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 28th September 2015, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined during office hours at Prestatyn Library, 21 Kings Avenue, Prestatyn, LL19 9AA and at the offices of the undersigned.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 22nd September 2015 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**Lengths of Road at Prestatyn in the County of Denbigh  
SCHEDULE 1 - No Waiting Loading and Unloading At Any Time**

Street	Side	Location
Bastion Road	West	From a point 15 metres north of the projected northerly kerbline of The Mall for a distance of 38 metres in a southerly direction
The Mall	Both	From the projected westerly kerbline of Bastion Road for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction
