Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, dim cynt na 7 diwrnod ar ôl yr 14 Hydref 2015, sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag teithio ar hyd y rhan hwnnw o'r ffordd Dosbarth III a elwir yn Eyarth i Haymakers, Llanfair D.C. yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â'r A494 at ei chyffordd â chroesffordd Tan y Coed i Eyarth Lodge. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn hwyluso gwaith gosod wyneb newydd ar y ffordd gan Uned Waith – Cyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer traffig, fydd wedi'i ddangos gan arwyddion, fydd ar hyd yr A494, A525, ac Eyarth i Ffordd Haymakers. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 6 Tachwedd 2015, am gyfnod o 18 mis neu tan y bydd y gwaith wedi ei gwblhau, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 2 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 14th October 2015 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of Class III road known as Eyarth to Haymakers, Llanfair D.C. in the County of Denbigh, which extends from its junction with A494 to its junction with Tan y Coed to Eyarth Lodge crossroads. The closure is necessary to facilitate resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council – Works Unit.

The signposted alternative route available for traffic will be via A494, A525, and Eyarth to Haymakers Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 6th November 2015 for an eighteen month period or earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. It is anticipated the works will last approximately 2 weeks.
