**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER  
DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 16 ST. ASAPH  
NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

On 9th December 2014, Denbighshire County Council made an Order which prohibits pedestrians from using Public Footpath No. 16 in the community of St. Asaph.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the protection of the public during construction of a sub station access road for Gwynt y Mor Offshore Windfarm Ltd at St. Asaph.

The current Order expires on 13th December 2015, but to facilitate the continuation of construction works this has been extended by a further 6 month period until 13th June 2016, with the approval of the Welsh Ministers using powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991).
