Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu, ymhen dim llai na 7 diwrnod wedi 13 Ionawr 2016, gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd cerbydau rhag teithio ar hyd y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd Dosbarth III a adwaenir fel ffordd Loggerheads i Cilcain, ger Llanferres yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â'r A494 i gyfeiriad y gogledd orllewin am bellter o oddeutu 227 metr.

Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn hwyluso adeiladu mynedfa newydd i faes parcio gan uned gwaith CSDd.

Bydd y llwybr amgen wedi'i arwyddo ac yn mynd ar hyd ffordd Tafarn y Gelyn i. Cilcain, Tafarn y Gelyn a'r A494. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr trwy gydol y cyfnod y bydd y ffordd ar gau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 1 Chwefror 2016 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaith yn para tua 2 fis.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 13th January 2016 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of Class III road known as Loggerheads to Cilcain road, near Llanferres in the County of Denbigh, which extends from its junction with A494 in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 227 metres.

The closure is necessary to facilitate construction of a new car park entrance by D.C.C. works unit.

The signposted alternative route will be via Tafarn y Gelyn to Cilcain road, Tafarn y Gelyn and A494. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 1st February 2016 for an eighteen month period or the earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. The works are expected to last approximately 2 months.
