Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu, ymhen dim llai na 7 diwrnod wedi 24 Chwefror 2016, gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd cerbydau rhag teithio ar hyd y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd Dosbarth III a elwir yn ffordd Tan Llan i Bryn Teg i groesffordd, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Ffordd Cwm i gyfeiriad y gorllewin am bellter o oddeutu 428 metr. Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn i Gallagher Construction osod dwythell BT.

Y llwybr amgen wedi'i arwyddo fydd ar hyd Ffordd Waen, Ffordd Llanelwy a Ffordd Cwm. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr ar gael drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 14 Mawrth 2016 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaith yn para tua 5 diwrnod.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 24th February 2016 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of Class III road at Cwm in the County of Denbigh known as Tan Llan road from Bryn Teg to crossroads which extends from its junction with Cwm Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 428 metres. The closure is necessary to facilitate works by Gallagher Construction on behalf of BT.

The signposted alternative route will be via Waen Road, St. Asaph Road and Cwm Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 14th March 2016 for an eighteen month period or the earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. The works are expected to last approximately 5 days.
