ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SECTION 14(1)

The County Borough of Conwy
(Footpath 24 (part) in the Community of Trefriw)
(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians)
Order 2009

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Conwy County Borough Council has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian to proceed in that length of Footpath 24 in the Community of Trefriw in the County Borough of Conwy commencing at its junction with footpath 22 at grid reference SH7821 6331 and proceeding in a northerly then easterly direction for approximately 550m and ending at grid reference SH7850 6353 and that section of footpath 24 commencing at grid reference SH7920 6220 and proceeding in a southerly then south easterly direction for approximately 750m to grid reference SH7934 6158.

The Order is necessary for the reason of likelihood of danger to the public.

The Order comes into effect on 3 September 2009. It is anticipated that the footpath will be closed until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, subject to a maximum period of 6 months. Dated 2 September 2009
