

Gorchymyn Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (Ceî Conwy)

Mae Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn dan Adranau 1(1), 2(1) i (3) a Rhan IV Atodlen 9, Deddf Rheoli Trafnidiaeth Ffyrdd 1984, i ddiwygio Gorchymyn Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (Ceî Conwy) Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros 2007 mewn perthynas yn unig â'r darnau o ffordd a nodir yn Atodleni 1, 2 a 3 y Rhybudd hwn. Y rheswm dros y Gorchymyn hwn yw newid y rheoliadau trafnidiaeth presennol er mwyn cyd-fynd â gosodiad parcio presennol Ceî Conwy. Effaith hyn fydd ymestyn y lle parcio i bob anabl o 6 metr a lleihau'r gofod parcio a ganiateir i berchnogion cychod o 3 metr.

The County Borough of Conwy (Conwy Quay)

(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2007

(Amendment) Order 2009

The Conwy County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1),2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will amend the Conwy County Borough Council (Conwy Quay) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order 2007 insofar only as it relates to the lengths of road specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Notice.

The reason for this Order is to amend the current traffic regulations to bring into line with the current parking layout on Conwy Quay. The effect of this will be to extend the length of the disabled parking bay by 6 metres and reduce the permitted boat owners parking bay by 3 metres.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Conwy Library and at the offices of the Head of Legal & Democratic Services, Bodlondeb, Conwy during normal opening/office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the Head of Legal & Democratic Services, Conwy County Borough Council, Bodlondeb, Conwy, LL32 8DU by 28 October 2009.

Schedule 1

(No waiting at any time)

Conwy Quay	Both sides; from its junction with Town Ditch Road to its junction with Conwy Road, except on its north-easterly side, from a point 113 metres south-east of Lower High Street for a distance of 31 metres in a south-easterly direction

Schedule 2

(Permitted Boat Owners only, waiting limited to 60 minutes, no return within 120 minutes)

Conwy Quay	North-easterly side; from a point 126 metres south-east of Lower High Street for a distance of 18 metres in a south-easterly direction

Schedule 3

(Disabled parking only)

Conwy Quay	North-easterly side; from a point 113 metres south-east of Lower High Street for a distance of 13 metres in a south-easterly direction
