(2) cerddwyr neu farchogion fynd ar hyd rhan o lwybr cyhoeddus rhif 32 wrth Blas yr Esgob, Llanely yn Sir Ddinbych o'i gyffordd hefo llwybr cyhoeddus rhif 16 i gyfeiriad dwyreiniol am bellter o 101 metr.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hyrwyddo gwarchod y cyhoedd yn ystod cyfnod adeiladu ffodd fynediad i is-orsaf fferm wynt Gwynt y Môr Ltd ger Llanely.

Does dim llwybrau gwahanol i gerddwyr.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

FOOTPATH 16 AND BRIDLEWAY 32 OFF GLASCOED ROAD, ST ASAPH

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN AND BRIDLE ACCESS ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 26th November 2009 to make an Order which will prohibit:

(1) any pedestrian from using that part of Public Footpath No. 16 at St Asaph Business Park, St Asaph in the County of Denbigh from its junction with B5381 Glascoed Road and running in a southerly direction to its junction with Public Bridleway No. 32 and

(2) pedestrian or bridle access along that part of Public Bridleway No. 32 at Plas yr Esgob, St Asaph in the County of Denbigh from its junction with Public Footpath No. 16 in an easterly direction for a distance of 101 metres.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the protection of the public during construction of a sub-station access road for Gwynt y Mor Offshore Windfarm Ltd at St Asaph

There is no alternative route available for pedestrian or bridle access.

The Order will come into force on 14th December 2009 and remain in force for a period of six months.
