

CYNGOR SIR DDINBYCH (PWLL-Y-GRAWYS, STRYD Y BONT A LLAIN HENLLAN, DINBYCH) GORCHYMYN (GWAHARDD AROS, LLWYTHO A DADLWYTHO) 2009 DEDDF RHEOLEIDDIO TRAFFIG FFORDD 1984

Ar 24 Tachwedd 2009 gwnaeth Cyngor Sir Ddinbych orchymyn dan Adranau 1(1) a (2), 2(1) i (3) a 4(2) a (3) 32, 35, 45, 47, 49, 51, 52 a 124 a Rhan IV o Atodlen 9 i Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig 1984, gyda'r effaith o aros, llwytho a dadlwytho cerbydau rhag aros ar y darn o ffordd ac ar yr adeg a nodir yn yr Atodlen i'r Rhybudd hwn.

Darperir eithriadau yn y Gorchymyn arfaethedig i ganiatáu aros ar y darnau o Ffordd y cyfeirir atynt yn Rhestr 1 i bwrpas llwytho, byrddio, a gwaith cynnal a chadw, atgyweirio a'i debyg a darnau o ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 2 i lwytho a dadlwytho.

Bydd eithriadau hefyd yn y Gorchymyn arfaethedig i ganiatáu i gerbydau sy'n arddangos bathodyn person anabl a disg parcio person anabl aros am gyfnod heb fod yn fwy na 3 awr (nad yw'n gyfnod a wahanir gan egwyl o lai nag 1 awr o'r cyfnod aros blaenorol gan yr un cerbyd ar yr un diwrnod) ar y darnau o ffordd a nodir yn Rhestr 2 isod.

Caiff Gorchymyn Atgyfnerthu Cyngor Sir Ddinbych (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu Aros a Mannau Parcio Stryd) 2004 ei addasu cyn belled ag y mae'n ymwneud â'r darn penodol hwn o'r ffordd.

Gellir astudio copi o'r Gorchymyn a ddaw i rym ar 30 Tachwedd 2009 ynghyd â map yn dangos y darn o'r ffordd y mae'r Gorchymyn arfaethedig yn ymwneud ag o, yn Llyfrgell Dinbych, Sgwâr y Neuadd, Dinbych ac yn swyddfeydd y sawl sydd wedi llofnodi isod, yn ystod oriau swyddfa arferol.

Os dymunwch holl cywirdeb y Gorchymyn neu unrhyw ddarpariaeth a gynhwysir ynddo oherwydd nad yw o fewn pwerau Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffordd 1984 neu oherwydd bod unrhyw ofyniad o'r Ddeddf neu unrhyw offeryn a wnaed o dano ddim wedi'i gadw mewn perthynas â'r Gorchymyn, gallwch o fewn 6 wythnos o 26 Tachwedd 2009 wneud cais i'r Uchel Lys i'r diben hwn.

DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (LENTEN POOL, BRIDGE STREET AND HENLLAN PLACE, DENBIGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2009

On 24 November 2009 Denbighshire County Council made the above-named Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and (3) 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 52, and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles in the lengths of road specified, and at the times specified in the Schedules below.

Exceptions are provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting in the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 for the purposes of alighting, boarding, and works of maintenance, repair and the like and on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 for loading and unloading also.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc to wait for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day) on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 below.

The Denbighshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 is amended in so far as it relates to the said length of road.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on the 30 November 2009, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined at Denbigh Library, Hall Square Denbigh and at County Hall, Wynnstay Road, Ruthin during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 26 November 2009 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Lengths of Road at Denbigh in the County of Denbigh. Schedule 1 No Waiting At Any Time/No Loading at Any Time

Lenten Pool.

South side;

From its junction with Glas Meadow Lane to a point 18 metres east of the projected easterly kerblines of Glas Meadow Lane

From a point 65 metres east of the projected easterly kerblines of Glas Meadow Lane to its junction with Bridge Street

Bridge Street.

South side;

From its junction with Lenten Pool to a point 43 metres west of the projected westerly kerblines of Highgate

North side;

From its junction with Lenten Pool to a point 64 metres west of the projected westerly building line of Rosemary Lane

Henllan Place (Barkers Well Lane leg).

East side;

From its junction with Lenten Pool to its junction with Pantton Hall

Lenten Pool

North side;

From its junction with Henllan Place (Barkerswell Lane leg) to its junction with the private access road leading to Llys y Grawys

Henllan Place (Barkers Well Lane direction)

West side;

From its junction with Lenten Pool to its junction with Henllan Place (Henllan Street leg)
