

STATUTORY NOTICE TO DISCONTINUE DEE ROAD JUNIORS SCHOOL AND CUSTOM HOUSE LANE JUNIOR SCHOOL AND TO ESTABLISH A NEW COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL

FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Sections 28(1)(a) and 29(1)(a) of the Schools Standards and Framework Act 1998 and the Education (School Organisation Proposals) (Wales) Regulations 1999 (SI1999/1671) as amended, that Flintshire County Council of County Hall, Mold, having consulted such persons as appeared to them to be appropriate, propose to:

- Discontinue Dee Road Infants School
- Discontinue Custom House Lane Junior School
- Establish a newly built 360 + 30 Nursery place community school for boys and girls aged 3-11 years at the adjoining school field site of the above former two schools, being Mold Road, Connah's Quay, Deeside, Flintshire CH5 4QL.

It is proposed to implement the proposals to discontinue the above two schools on 31st August 2012 and to implement the proposal to establish the new school on 1st September 2012.

It is proposed that all pupils registered at Dee Road Infants School and Custom House Lane Junior School as at 31st August 2012 may attend the new school due to be established on 1st September 2012.

The proposed new school will be a Community Primary School. Admission arrangements will be dealt with in line with the LEA's Admission Policy. No provision will be made for either selection by aptitude or pupil banding.

Transport of pupils shall be dealt with by reference to the LEA's Home to School Transport Policy.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the new school at age four years in the first school year of which the proposals have been implemented is 51. Flintshire County Council as the LEA will be the admission authority.

Within a period of two months after the date of publication of these proposals, that is to say by 16th February 2010 any person may object to the proposals. Objections should be sent to the Director of Lifelong Learning, Flintshire County Council, County Hall, Mold, Flintshire CH7 6ND.

The Authority will send copies of any such objections made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the objection period, together with their observations thereon, to the Welsh Ministers within the period of one month after the end of the objection period.

The proposals will (unless withdrawn) require the approval of the Welsh Ministers if:

- (a) Within two months after a copy of them is sent to the Assembly it gives notice that they require such approval; or
- (b) Objections have been made within the objection period and have not been withdrawn during that period.

Where proposals do not require such approval, Flintshire County Council acting as LEA will decide whether to implement them within 4 months of the copy of the published proposals having been sent to the Welsh Ministers.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This is not part of the notice but is intended to explain its general purpose.

Flintshire County Council acting as the Local Education Authority intends to amalgamate Dee Road Infants School and Custom House Lane Junior School, making a new all through Community Primary School with a single Headteacher and a single Governing Body. In order to do so the LEA must publish proposals to discontinue both existing schools and establish a new school.

It is intended that the newly built school will be established on the school field site of the present Custom House Lane Junior School. The existing schools will continue until 31st August 2012.

Pupils already registered at Dee Road Infants and Custom House Lane Junior Schools as at 31st August 2012 will automatically be offered a place at the new school.

HYSBYSIR TRWY HYN yn unol ag Adran 28(1)(a) a 29(1)(a) o Ddeddf Safonau a Fframwaith Ysgolion 1998 a'r Rheoliadau Addysg (Cynigion Trefniadaeth Ysgolion) (Cymru) 1999 (SI1999/1671) fel y'u diwygiwyd, bod Cyngor Sir y Fflint o Neuadd y Sir, Yr Wyddgrug, ar ôl ymgynghori â'r cyfryw bobl ag yr ymddangosai'n briodol iddynt hwy, yn bwriadu:

- Terfynu Ysgol Babanod Dee Road
- Terfynu Ysgol Iau Custom House Lane
- Sefydlu ysgol gymunedol a adeiladir o'r newydd i 360 + 30 lle Meithrin ar gyfer bechgyn a genethod 3-11 mydd oed ar safle cae ysgol cyfagos y ddwy gyn-ysgol uchod, sef Ffordd yr Wyddgrug, Cei Connah, Glannau Dyfrdwy, Sir y Fflint CH5 4QL.

Bwriedir gweithredu'r cynigion i derfynu'r ddwy ysgol uchod ar yr 31ain Awst 2012 ac i weithredu'r cynnig i sefydlu'r ysgol newydd ar y 1af Medi 2012.

Bwriedir i'r holl ddisgyblion sydd wedi'u cofrestru yn Ysgol Babanod Dee Road ac Ysgol Iau Custom House Lane ar 31ain Awst 2012 gael mynychu'r ysgol newydd sydd i fod i'w sefydlu ar y 1af Medi 2012.

Ysgol Gynradd Gymunedol fydd yr ysgol arfaethedig newydd. Byddir yn ymrîn â threfniadau derbyn yn unol â Pholisi Derbyn yr AALI. Ni fydd dim darpariaeth yn cael ei gwneud ar gyfer naill ai dethol trwy ddeddfyrd neu fando disgyblion.

Byddir yn ymrîn â chludo disgyblion trwy gyfeirio at Bolisi Cludiant rhwng y Cartref a'r Ysgol yr AALI.

Nifer y disgyblion sydd i'w derbyn i'r ysgol newydd yn bedair blwydd oed yn y flwyddyn ysgol gyntaf y mae'r cynigion wedi'u gweithredu yw 51. Cyngor Sir y Fflint fel yr AALI fydd yr awdurdod derbyn.

O fewn cyfnod o ddau fis ar ôl dyddiad cyhoeddi'r cynigion hyn, hynny yw erbyn 16eg Chwefror 2010 gall unrhyw un wrthwynebu'r cynigion. Dylid anfon gwrthwynebiadau at Gyfarwyddwr Dysgu Gydol Oes, Cyngor Sir y Fflint, Neuadd y Sir, Yr Wyddgrug, Sir y Fflint CH7 6ND.

Bydd yr Awdurdod yn anfon copïau o unrhyw wrthwynebiadau o'r fath a wnaed (ac sydd heb eu tynnu'n ôl yn ysgrifenedig) o fewn y cyfnod gwrthwynebu, ynghyd â'u sylwadau am hynny, at Gweinidogion Cymru o fewn y cyfnod o fis ar ôl diwedd y cyfnod gwrthwynebu.

Bydd y cynigion (oni bai y cânt eu tynnu'n ôl) ag angen cymeradwyaeth Gweinidogion Cymru os:

- (a) O fewn dau fis wedi i gopi ohonynt gael ei anfon i'r Cynulliad y mae'n rhoi hysbysiad bod arnynt angen cymeradwyaeth o'r fath; neu
- (b) Bod gwrthwynebiadau wedi'u gwneud o fewn y cyfnod gwrthwynebu ac nad ydynt wedi'u tynnu'n ôl yn ystod y cyfnod hwnnw.

Ble nad yw cynigion ag angen cymeradwyaeth o'r fath, bydd Cyngor Sir y Fflint, yn gweithredu fel AALI, yn penderfynu pa un ai i'w gweithredu o fewn 4 mis wedi i'r copi o'r cynigion cyhoeddedig gael eu hanfon at Gweinidogion Cymru.
