

LICENSING ACT 2003 - NOTICE OF APPLICATION

An application has been made for the variation of a premises licence to allow the following licensable activities to take place:- Sale of alcohol on and off premises / Provision of regulated entertainment (Once a week or occasional)

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for making a false statement is a level 5 fine on the standard scale.
